THIS CONTRACT ("Contract") is entered into this 29th day of March 2021, by and between the National Hosting Authority ("the Client") having its principal place of business at **Sea King Building, MID Works Drive, and SS Environmental and Social Assessment** ("the Consultant") having its principal office located at **Naha 1, Central Honiara**.

WHEREAS, the Client wishes to have the Consultant perform the services hereinafter referred to, and

WHEREAS, the Consultant is willing to perform these services,

NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES hereby agree as follows:

1. Services

- (i) The Consultant shall perform the services specified in Annex A, "Terms of Reference and Scope of Services," which is made an integral part of this Contract ("the Services").
- (ii) The Consultant shall provide the personnel listed in Annex B, "Consultant's Personnel," to perform the Services.
- (iii) The Consultant shall submit to the Client the reports in the form and within the time periods specified in Annex C, "Consultant's Reporting Obligations."

2. Term

The Consultant shall perform the Services during the period commencing 29th March 2021 and continuing through 14th May 2021, or any other period as may be subsequently agreed by the parties in writing.

3. Payment

A. Ceiling

For Services rendered pursuant to Annex A, the Client shall pay the Consultant an amount not to exceed **\$118,000.00SBD**. This amount has been established based on the understanding that it includes all of the Consultant's costs and profits as well as any tax obligation that may be imposed on the Consultant.

B. Schedule of Payments

The schedule of payments is specified below:

- 40% shall be paid upon signing of contract.
- 60% shall be paid upon receipt of a comprehensive and detailed environmental report.

C. Payment Conditions

Payment shall be made in Solomon Islands Bokolo Dollars, no later than 15 days following submission by the Consultant of invoices in duplicate, to the Coordinator designated in paragraph 4

D. Tax Liability

Where payment is subject SIG tax law, any applicable taxes will be deducted from Consultants invoice before payment. The latest information on the relevant withholding taxes and other payables are to be found on the website of the Inland Revenue Department: <http://www.ird.gov.sb>

4. Project Administration

A. Coordinator.

The Client designates Mr. Christian Nieng as Client's Coordinator; the Coordinator will be responsible for the coordination of activities under this Contract, for acceptance and approval of the reports and of other deliverables by the Client and for receiving and approving invoices for the payment.

B. Reports.

The reports listed in Annex C, "Consultant's Reporting Obligations," shall be submitted in the course of the assignment, and will constitute the basis for the payments to be made under paragraph 3.

5. Performance Standards

The Consultant undertakes to perform the Services with the highest standards of professional and ethical competence and integrity. The Consultant shall promptly replace any employees assigned under this Contract that the Client considers unsatisfactory. If the Consultant after written notice is still considered not performing in accordance with Clause 1 "Services", the Client may terminate the contract by written notice.

6. Confidentiality

The Consultants shall not, during the term of this Contract and within two years after its expiration, disclose any proprietary or confidential information relating to the Services, this Contract or the Client's business or operations without the prior written consent of the Client.

7. Ownership of Material

Any studies reports or other material, graphic, software or otherwise, prepared by the Consultant for the Client under the Contract shall belong to and remain the property of the Client. The Consultant may retain a copy of such documents and software.

8. Consultant Not to be Engaged in Certain Activities

The Consultant agrees that, during the term of this Contract and after its termination, the Consultant and any entity affiliated with the Consultant, shall be disqualified from providing goods, works or services (other than the Services and any continuation thereof) for any project resulting from or closely related to the Services.

9. Insurance

The Consultant will be responsible for taking out any appropriate insurance coverage, including the liability of the Consultant.

10. Assignment

The Consultant shall not assign this Contract or sub-contract any portion of it without the Client's prior written consent.

11. Law Governing Contract and Language

The Contract shall be governed by the laws of The Solomon Islands and the language of the Contract shall be English.

12. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute arising out of the Contract, which cannot be amicably settled between the parties, shall be referred to adjudication/arbitration in accordance with the laws of the **Solomon Islands**.

Solomon Islands is preparing to host the 2023 Pacific Games in Honiara and the National Hosting Authority (NHA) is preparing sites to prepare sporting facilities within Honiara. Before constructions of the venues are underway, site preparations need to be conducted. Part of this preparation is to have preliminary surveys such as Environmental Assessments done. This scope involves the environmental assessment of MAL Farm, formerly known as Taiwanese farm, which will accommodate the new Solomon Islands Football Federation complex. The NHA therefore calls on registered companies and firms to submit quotations for the services described herein.

The scope of work to be carried out by the contractor is expected to include, but is not limited to the

Sol2023 may elect to use one or more contractors.

It was found that all firms meet the minimum requirements and that all are legally registered firms and companies. The evaluation finally came down to costings. Since all firms met all the legislative and timeframe requirements, the Committee is in agreement that the lowest cost be awarded the tender to minimize all necessary cost. Therefore, SS Environment & Social Assessment with a bidding price of **\$118,800.00SBD** is recommended to be awarded the tender for Environmental Assessment of MAL Farm.

TEC Decision: After due deliberations, the TEC approves to recommend SS Environment & Social Assessment to be awarded to carry out environmental assessment of MAL Farm at a cost of **\$118,800.00SBD**.

4. **Discussion 3:** Agenda (c)- On the 1st of December 2020, the TEC had deliberated on submission of expressions of interest for an engineering consultant that was advertised for 1 week and closed on 27/11/20. Submissions were received from Azimuth Surveys, Kramer Ausenco, Green Pacifika, Engineering Environmental Services Ltd and Mauritewa. From these five submissions, Kramer Ausenco, Azimuth Surveys and Mauritewa were shortlisted to be issued a Request for Proposal. (IGTB/TEC Meeting 07/20_agenda C). Following the decision as briefly summarized above, an RFP was issued to the 3 shortlisted firms. Out of the three, only Azimuth Surveys and Mauritewa submitted their proposal.

2. **Discussion 1: Agenda (a)-** Evaluation team member begins with preliminary evaluation on submissions from two (2) tenderers. Preliminary evaluation involves checking of legality of the business, equipment & timeframe to deliver the task and costs. It is noted that this tender was re-advertised as there were no responses to the first advertisement, which ran from 20/11/20-04/12/20. Since there was no submissions, the tender was re-advertised and closed on 21/12/20. Upon the closing date of the re-advertisement, the two submissions were received from Hansen Planning Co. Ltd and Mauritewa. Summary of submission are as follows:

The estimated budget for this survey works is **\$205,680.00SBD**. It is found that both firms have the technical and financial capability to carry out the works. Therefore, the TEC recommends that the tender be awarded to the lowest responsive bidder who is Mauritewa at a bidding price of **\$179,640.00SBD**. The Evaluation Report presents the details of the grounds for award.

TEC Decision: After due deliberations, the TEC has agreed that the tender for Geotech survey of MAL farm, GTB 03-11/20 be awarded to Mauritewa with a bidding price of **\$179,640.00SBD**.

3. **Discussion 2: Agenda (b)-** The tender for Environmental Assessment of MAL Far, GTB 04-11/20 was advertised from 20/11/20 – 04/12/20. Bidding documents were collected by PM Environment and Pari Development Co. Ltd. However, on the closing date, no submissions were received and so the tender had to be re-advertised. EXAMINATION OF TENDERS (RFP)

Tenders (RFP) were opened at NHA conference room at sea king building at 11:00am on 23rd December 2020 by NHA TEC. Tenders (RFP) were examined for qualification criteria and the results are shown in the attached tender preliminary evaluation in **Appendix A**.

The **three (3)** tenderers were qualified/shortlisted for consideration of their tenders:

1. FBP Consultancy services
2. SS Environmental & social assessment
3. Telios Consultancy.

EVALUATION

Each of the three (3) shortlisted tenderers met the minimum qualification criteria and fully complied with the requirements and were evaluated on their own merit. Key outtakes as follows:

1. Legally registered business
2. Met the minimum qualifications
3. Have significant experiences in Solomon Islands and other pacific countries with projects of a similar nature over the last 3 – 5 years.

FUNDING

Funding is being through *the Solomon Islands Government (SIG)*.

There was no initial budget for this project.

EXAMINATION OF TENDERS (RFP)

The three contractors submitted their fees for this work. Fees supplied by FBP Consultancy is the highest \$510,900.00. Telios consultancy services fee appeared a bit lower from FBP which is \$367,800.00. SS environmental & social assessment is the lowest bidder with an amount of \$118,800.00.
